In addition to launching **two world premieres**, the first being **KAOS on Saturday September 26**, we will feature select works from our archives for viewing and conversation in live streamed events. Dates are listed below within our season listings.

KAOS Premieres Saturday, September 26, 2020 at 3:00 pm

Hedwig Dances launches its 20/21 season of dance with **KAOS**, a new interdisciplinary world premiere by Company dancer and choreographer Rigoberto Saura.

Responding to recent transformative world events, **KAOS** reflects on our collective fears of exposure to turbulent situations as a brave beginning to reimagine new forms of order. Saura's work explores the chaos/order dichotomy by using digital platforms that juxtapose dance for the camera with virtual "live" segments.

Saura collaborates with Herry Labrada, a Cuban-born, Netherlands-based dancer and musician whose sound score fuses pre-recorded voice, electronic music and DJ techniques.
